Role Title: Fundraising Engagement Volunteer

Why we need you

We know that for young lives, when the doctor says cancer, normal life stops. Cancer affects every part of life – relationships, confidence, money, school, work. Young Lives vs Cancer care teams will fight tirelessly to limit the damage cancer causes.

As Fundraising Engagement Volunteer you'll be helping to raise awareness and increase income to Young Lives vs Cancer by supporting the fundraising team. Your role will be to help support local events and help represent the charity in your local community. This role is varied, very flexible and essential to ensuring Young Lives vs Cancer's presence is felt far and wide.

What you'll be doing

Support with organising fundraising events in your area, this could mean supporting your:

- Fundraising Engagement Manager, other Young Lives vs Cancer supporters or arranging one yourself
- Representing the charity at events and cheque presentations
- Organising and participating in bucket collections
- Recruiting other volunteers to help at events
- Placing collection tins in various locations
- Raising awareness

What skills or experience you'll need

- You should be aged 18 or over
- You'll care about Young Lives vs Cancer and want to help limit the damage cancer causes for children and young people beyond their health
- Knowledge of your local area and the willingness to travel within it

- Confident when talking and approaching new people
- Proactive approach to getting things done
- Commitment to our values: We Are Brave, We Are Confident, We Have Integrity And We Are One Team

Your dedicated Fundraising Engagement Manager will support you in your role and:

- You'll get an induction into Young Lives vs Cancer and our work
- We'll cover your expenses for the time that you volunteer with us
- Your volunteering will have a big impact on our continued fight for young lives against cancer and our drive to reach even more young lives
- Mostly you'll be able to feel amazing knowing that you are using your time to support children and young people affected by cancer
- There is also the opportunity to develop this role by participating in other areas of fundraising if you would like to do so
